5. All abstract submitters will be notified by the scientific committee (SC) of their **decision by July 20, 2022**.
6. All presenters of accepted abstracts are expected to **attend the congress**.
7. Abstracts will be selected for **oral or poster presentations**. Each oral presentation will last 10 minutes.
8. Abstracts and congress proceedings will be **published in the international journal 'Annals of Nutrition and Metabolism'**.
